

Dearest Grace-Calvary Family,

I would like to provide you with an update on repairs to St Julian Hall. Back in August I communicated to you that we were anticipating completion of repairs by the end of October. Since that time a Building Committee was formed to evaluate both remediation of potential, future flooding and repairs of existing damage. We engaged a professional engineer to perform stormwater assessment recommendations. Some of the remediation options included potentially modifying some of the exterior walls and roof overhangs. We delayed interior and exterior wall repair while we were considering possible modifications to the roof and overhang to manage storm water flow. Fortunately, these modifications were deemed unnecessary. The Committee determined the scope of the work is now confined to external and interior wall repairs that don't modify the architecture in any way. We are delighted to report that we can now proceed with the repairs needed. Additionally, the roof of St. Julian Hall was inspected by multiple professionals, and it was determined that replacement could be deferred for at least another year, if not a few years.

I would like to thank David Todd, and all of the members of the Building Committee. This group is comprised of David Todd, Rich Madrid, Tim Williams, Mary Fry, Jaracoe Jackson, Sam White, and Bobby Aycock. Their combined knowledge and professional experience guided thoughtful, proactive responses to the issues we have with St Julian Hall. David stepped up to form the committee and has been a champion of restoring our beloved space. This group meets on a weekly basis and often more than that. They have walked the site with multiple contractors and are currently evaluating and requesting more bids from contractors for repairs.

Now that the scope of work has been reduced to actual repairs and excludes remediation, the Building Committee expects to commence repair work as early as mid-November.
